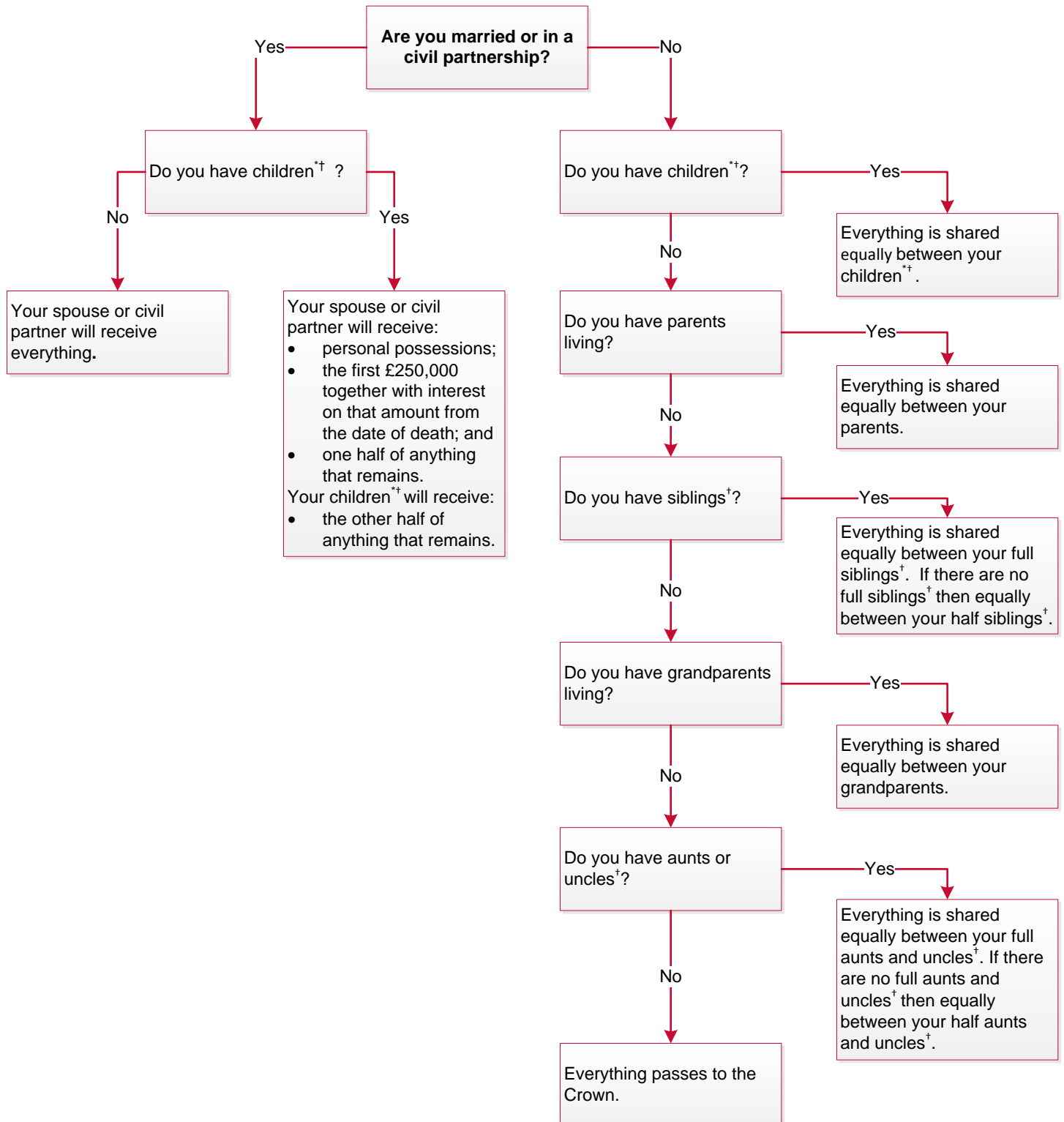


## How the intestacy rules could affect you and your family

The current rules which were updated in October 2014 are summarised below.



<sup>\*</sup> The term children includes illegitimate and adopted children, but not step-children.

<sup>†</sup> If those relatives were not living at the date of your death but they left descendants who are, then those descendants would usually inherit the share their parent would have taken had they survived you.
